I am e3

I am e3 is a simple and engaging resource to help people share their faith stories. Use this deck of 23 cards in parish gatherings, sacramental preparation programs, committee and staff meetings, and other settings.

Sharing your faith is easy. These cards will help you share your faith through real life experiences. Visit us at www.iame3.org for more tips on using e3 cards.

Here's how to use the I am e3 cards.

1. You will need from 20 to 60 minutes to complete a round of e3. Determine the time you will allot to e3.
2. Break up into groups of two (or three). Based on the time allotted, determine how much time each person receives.
3. Give each person his/her own card. Participants don't need to pick a specific card.
4. Direct the participants to read their card silently when they receive it. The first person to start reads his/her card to the others in the group.
5. That person then shares his/her own story by answering the questions at the bottom of the card.
6. The group participants listen to, affirm, and thank the speaker. This is not a time to give advice however.
7. Repeat steps 4 to 6 for each one in the group.
8. If there is time when everyone finishes, some may want to share with the whole group about their e3 experience.
9. Participants may keep their card and take it home with them. They can show it to those at home and tell them about their e3 experience.
